### **Instructions:**

1. All forms must be completed and returned directly to Tom Statham at the address above.
2. Make sure you have first read the Registration Information packet.
3. If going on High Adventure Trek, sign up for desired trek. Do not sign up for merit badges or whitewater trip. Information on the treks and age requirements are in the Registration Information packet.
4. List merit badge choices for each MB period. Use the schedule provided in the Registration Information packet.
5. Sign-up for offsite activities. Select the whitewater trip your Scout will take. Scouts must be 13 and have whitewater experience to go on the Ocoee trip. As an option, or as an addition, Scouts can sign up for the Horsemanship MB. If an addition to a whitewater trip, then there is an additional \$35 charge.
6. Indicate if you are willing to drive either on Sunday to take the Scouts to camp or on Saturday to bring the Scouts home.
7. Fill out and sign Troop 317 Camp Permission Slip (Electronic signed upon registration).
8. Fill out and sign either the Nantahala or Ocoee Permission slips depending on which whitewater trip your Scout is going on. If your son is going on any high adventure trek, sign both. These can be obtained by going to the following website: <http://wsr.atlantabsacamp.org/info.asp>
9. Fill out Horseback Permission slip <http://wsr.atlantabsacamp.org/info.asp> if your Scout is going to take the Horsemanship merit badge or if he is going on the Ultimate Zone.

### 1. High Adventure Treks

Woodruff offers 3 optional high adventure treks for older Scouts. These treks are explained in the Registration Information packet. All treks last the entire week and take the place of merit badge classes and afternoon activity periods. If a Scout signs up for a high adventure trek, then he should not sign up for merit badges or a whitewater trip. In addition, waivers will be required for each high adventure activity.

### 2. Merit Badge Signup

List merit badge for each morning period. See Registration Information packet for merit badge schedule. You have 4 merit badge periods in the morning and can do one additional merit badge in the afternoon in place of patrol activities. Every Scout should have a full morning schedule. Please note that some merit badges are 2 periods long. If you are signing up for COPE, then enter COPE in periods 2, 3 and 4 and select a merit badge for period 1.

Mountain Man participants (first year Scouts) should sign up for Mountain Man for periods 1 and 2 and Swimming MB for periods 3 and 4.

**3. White Water Trip and Horsemanship Merit Badge (off site activities)**
